

Guidelines for the preparation and submission of applications for the Edna Waddell Scholarship

Your application must reach the Scholarships Office of the university where you intend to enroll by 1 October.

These guidelines are intended to help you with your application. If you have any questions that are not answered here you should contact the Scholarships Office at your university.

Before proceeding with your application make sure you have read and understood the regulations and that you are eligible to apply for this scholarship.

General information:

Up to three scholarships are awarded to New Zealand students each year. You should submit your application to the Scholarships Office at the university where you intend to enrol.

Applications and referees' reports must be received by 1 October.

Edna Waddell scholars shall:

- Hold the entry qualifications for their chosen degree. Be New Zealand citizens or permanent residents with at least three years proven residence in New Zealand.
- Show enthusiasm and some knowledge of technology and engineering, particularly in their chosen field.
- Have leadership and creative skills.

In addition, in considering each scholarship application the committee shall take into account:

- School academic record, particularly in mathematics
- Projects.
- Further education, extra mural courses, short courses or similar
- Relevant work experience.
- Creativity and innovative ability shown by the candidate.
- Enthusiasm for working in technology and engineering.

Academic records both at school and beyond will be used by the Scholarship Committee to select a short list of candidates.

Presentation:

The best possible presentation is important

- do not put cover sheets on your statements - they will only be discarded to avoid unnecessary copying.
- use only white, A4 paper.
- print on one side only.
- use a clip of some sort in the top left corner to hold the application together, not a staple.
- do not bind the application.

Check the application checklist for completeness
